



US reimposes sanctions on UN's Albanese for opposing Israel's crimes

The Trump regime has [put](#) UN human rights advocate Francesca Albanese back under punitive sanctions for her continued opposition to and scrutiny of Israel's crimes against the Palestinian people. US judge Richard Leon had [ordered](#) the lifting of sanctions after legal action by her husband and daughter, who are US citizens, but the government [appealed](#).

Now a panel of three Washington DC appeal judges have put an "administrative stay" on Leon's ruling. They described the stay as "procedural" only and insisted that they were making no judgment on the merits of Leon's decision or the Trump regime's appeal. But the White House immediately leaped on the opportunity to re-apply the sanctions.
